TASTING NOTES

A soft and juicy delight; deeply rich with plums, blackberries and blueberries, enhanced by subtle hints of mint and milk chocolate.

VINTAGE REGION

South Eastern Australia

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Heavy winter rains and a mild spring led to the production of strong canopies, which protected the fruit during the summer heat, and resulted in wines of great strength and character.

GRAPE VARIETY

Shiraz (83%), Cabernet Sauvignon (17%)

MATURATION

3 months French oak chips (5%) 5 months Stainless Steel (80%)
3 months American oak chips (5%)

COLOUR

Dark cherry red with vibrant purple hues.

NOSE

Deeply rich with plums, blackberries and blueberries, supported by a faint and refreshing mint and fresh herb note.

PALATE

Vibrant and rich with juicy blackberries and dark plums initially, followed by a delicious grated milk chocolate note; and finishing with a subtle refreshing splash of freshly picked mint. A soft, juicy and refreshing delight.
