TASTING NOTES

A soft and juicy delight; deeply rich with plums, blackberries and blueberries, enhanced by subtle hints of mint and milk chocolate

REGION

South Eastern Australia

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Following one of the warmest springs on record, with below average rainfall, vintage commenced slightly later than normal due to cooler December temperatures.

There were a number of rainfall events in the second week of January, but the remaining dry period and relatively cooler summer temperatures, with less extreme heat periods, provided ideal fruit ripening. Vintage 2015 will be seen as one of the top wine quality seasons.

GRAPE VARIETY

Shiraz (88%)

Cabernet Sauvignon (12%)

MATURATION

3 months French oak chips (5%)

3 months American oak chips (5%)

5 months Stainless Steel (90%)

COLOUR

Dark plum red with purple hues

NOSE

Lifted raspberries, plums and blackcurrant, with hints of white pepper and bay leaf.

PALATE

A vibrant burst of raspberries, plums and blackcurrants is closely followed by subtle white pepper and bay leaf, and finally a dusting of milk chocolate. A soft, juicy and refreshing delight!
