Vintage Conditions

The 2012 growing season was characterised by extended cool dry periods, punctuated by short warmer spells. This allowed for long slow ripening of the fruit, allowing the fruit to achieve optimal ripeness free of the threat of inclement weather.

Nose

Juicy pears and crisp citrus notes are set against a subtle but complex medley of cinnamon, nutmeg and tropical aromas.

Palate

Immediately refreshing and crisp. Pear juice, honey suckle and nutmeg, are freshened by zingy citrus and a hint of gooseberry. Perfect for a plate of seafood, or a late afternoon with friends.
