Vintage Conditions

The 2012 growing season was characterised by extended cool dry periods, punctuated by short warmer spells. This allowed for long slow ripening of the fruit, allowing the fruit to achieve optimal ripeness free of the threat of inclement weather.

Maturation

85% Stainless steel for 3mths, 10% French oak planks for 3mths, 5% 3yr old French barrels for 3mths.

Colour

A lovely dark rose petal red with light purple hues.

Nose

Fragrant with red cherries, subtle musk and warming spices of nutmeg and cinnamon.

Palate

A refreshing burst of red cherries and strawberries, followed by subtle notes of violets, cinnamon and the faintest hint of mint. Soft velvet-like tannins carry the wine towards a long and delicious finish.
