TASTING NOTES

This wine leaps from the glass and yells “drink me”. Alive with a rich medley of dark berries, plums and liquorice; supported by delicate milk chocolate and nutmeg notes and a long and mouth-watering finish.

VINTAGE REGION

South Australia

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Heavy winter rains and a mild spring led to the production of strong canopies, which protected the fruit during the summer heat, and resulted in wines of great strength and character.

GRAPE VARIETY

Shiraz (100%)

MATURATION

5 months in stainless steel (80%)

3 months on American oak planks (10%)

3 months on French oak

planks (10%)

COLOUR

Dark plum red with vibrant purple hues.

NOSE

Alive with a rich medley of dark berries, plums and liquorice, complemented by subtle milk chocolate and nutmeg notes.

PALATE

This wine bursts onto the palate with sweet juicy plums and dark berries, before unfolding into luscious milk chocolate and liquorice. A subtle spice note joins in, as this delicious wine meanders towards a long and mouth-watering finish.
