McLaren Vale GSM 2011

GSM is Rosemount Estate's expression of a traditional old-world blend. First released in 1994, this wine is crafted from Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre sourced from McLaren Vale. The rich and spicy fruit flavours of old bush vine Grenache balance the opulent power of Syrah and the firm structure of Mourvedre. This wine demonstrates a balance of ripe raspberry, black cherry and lifted floral spice, with a supple tannin finish.

Rosemount's GSM is highly attractive in its youth and has the proven ability to cellar for up to 10 years with careful cellaring.

Vintage Conditions

Good winter rains and a warm spring lead to early budburst and flowering during spring. The ripening period between February and March was cool and wetter than normal resulting in a later than normal start to vintage. The cooler ripening period allowed for a long flavour development, producing wines with great elegance and brightness.
